The **deadline** for applications each year is April 15.

We are grateful to the Grand Lodge of New Hampshire, particularly to those who have served as Worshipful Grand Master since 1991, who have promoted this Foundation through its Charity Fund Drive to the point where scholarships can be granted without using the principal.

Only complete applications will be considered and only those applications with a postmark on or before April 15. To be considered a complete application, you must submit the following:

- A signed scholarship application
- Latest available transcript of grades
- Reference letter from Mother Advisor
- Reference letter from High School Principal or Guidance Counselor
- Statement about why financial assistance is necessary
